Meaning: To demoralize means to weaken someone's confidence, enthusiasm, or morale, often through negative feedback or repeated failures.

1. The constant criticism from her peers began to demoralize her enthusiasm for the project.
2. After several defeats in a row, the team's spirit was starting to demoralize the players.
3. He refused to let the negative comments demoralize him and focused on his goals instead.
4. The harsh realities of the situation could easily demoralize even the most optimistic individuals.
5. Seeing his friends give up their dreams began to demoralize him, making him question his own aspirations.
