Meaning: To demount means to remove or detach something, typically a component or part, from its mounted position.

1. The technician had to demount the old engine before installing the new one.
2. To replace the tire, you will need to demount it from the wheel.
3. He carefully demounted the artwork from the wall to examine it for damage.
4. The team worked quickly to demount the scaffolding after the project was completed.
5. Before packing the equipment, they decided to demount all the components for easier transport.
