

DENTATE-SINUATE

Meaning: Dentate-sinuate refers to a leaf margin that is characterized by a combination of tooth-like serrations (dentate) and wavy or sinuous edges (sinuate).

1. The leaves of the plant were strikingly dentate-sinuate, with distinct serrations along the edges.
2. In her botanical illustrations, she often depicted the dentate-sinuate margins of various foliage to highlight their unique shapes.
3. The dentate-sinuate pattern on the shell of the mollusk added to its exotic appeal.
4. During the nature walk, we encountered several species that featured dentate-sinuate leaves, showcasing their adaptation to the environment.
5. The artist used a dentate-sinuate design to create a sense of movement in the floral composition.
