

DENTICULATION

Meaning: DENTICULATION: The presence of small, tooth-like projections or serrations on a surface, often seen in leaves or fossils, which can serve specific functions such as deterring herbivores or indicating evolutionary traits.

1. The denticulation of the leaves in this plant species helps to deter herbivores.
2. In paleontology, the denticulation on the edges of some fossils can indicate their evolutionary adaptations.
