

# DENTIROSTRAL

*Meaning: Dentirostral refers to a beak shape that is slender and pointed, adapted for probing or extracting food from crevices or surfaces.*

1. The dentirostral shape of the bird's beak allows it to efficiently probe for insects in tree bark.
2. Researchers noted that the dentirostral features of the species contributed to its unique feeding habits.
3. In ornithology, dentirostral adaptations are often associated with birds that extract food from hard-to-reach places.
4. The dentirostral structure of the finch's bill is perfectly suited for cracking open seeds.
5. Observing dentirostral birds in their natural habitat provides insight into their ecological roles and feeding strategies.
