Meaning: DENTIZE (verb): To create small indentations or grooves on a surface, typically to enhance adhesion or prepare it for finishing processes.

1. The technician had to dentize the metal surface before applying the final coat of paint.
2. To ensure a smooth finish, it's essential to dentize the edges of the material first.
3. After the initial repairs, the team decided to dentize the area for better adhesion.
4. She carefully dentized the wood to prepare it for the varnish application.
5. The artist found that dentizing the canvas helped the paint adhere better during the layering process.
