

DEOBSSTRUCT

Meaning: Deobstruct means to remove obstacles or barriers from a path or area to restore accessibility or flow.

1. The city council took immediate action to deobstruct the main street after the heavy snowfall.
2. Efforts to deobstruct the riverbank have significantly improved the local ecosystem.
3. In order to ensure safety, the workers were instructed to deobstruct all pathways before the event began.
4. The engineer devised a plan to deobstruct the clogged drainage system before the rainy season.
5. Community volunteers gathered to deobstruct the park trails and make them accessible for everyone.
