

DEPRECATINGLY

Meaning: In a manner that expresses disapproval or belittles something, often to downplay one's own achievements or to criticize.

1. She smiled deprecatingly, as if to downplay her recent accomplishments.
2. The coach spoke deprecatingly about the team's performance, highlighting their need for improvement.
3. He raised an eyebrow and chuckled deprecatingly at the overly ambitious proposal.
4. While she praised her colleagues, her tone remained deprecatingly self-critical.
5. The writer described his early work deprecatingly, emphasizing how much he had grown since then.
