Meaning: Deprecative: expressing disapproval or criticism, often in a way that belittles or diminishes value.

1. The teacher's deprecative comments about the students' work discouraged their enthusiasm for learning.
2. His deprecative tone during the meeting made it clear that he did not value the team's contributions.
3. Despite her deprecative remarks, her friends knew that she genuinely cared about their well-being.
4. The artist's deprecative attitude towards his own paintings surprised those who admired his talent.
5. In a deprecative manner, he dismissed the idea as impractical and unrealistic.
