Meaning: To depredate means to prey upon or destroy resources, often causing significant damage or depletion.

1. The invasive species began to depredate the native bird population, threatening its survival.
2. As the drought continued, the hungry animals started to depredate the remaining vegetation in the area.
3. Historically, pirates would depredate coastal towns, leaving destruction in their wake.
