

DEPUTIZE

Meaning: To appoint someone as a deputy or delegate authority to act on one's behalf, especially in a temporary capacity.

1. The manager decided to deputize her assistant during her absence to ensure the team remained on track.
2. In emergencies, the sheriff can deputize volunteers to help maintain public safety.
3. As a way to empower his team, he chose to deputize several members for special projects.
4. The council voted to deputize additional officers to handle the growing demands of the community.
5. During the training session, the instructor will deputize a few participants to demonstrate the new procedures.
