Meaning: To descry means to catch sight of or discern something that is difficult to see, often due to distance or obscurity.

1. She could barely descry the faint outline of the ship in the fog.
2. With his keen eyesight, he was able to descry the distant mountains through the haze.
3. As they climbed higher, they began to descry the valley below filled with autumn colors.
4. It took a moment for her to descry the figure moving silently among the trees.
