

DESINENT

Meaning: Desinent (noun): the ending of a verb that indicates its conjugation and grammatical information in different tenses.

1. The teacher explained that the desinent of a verb indicates its conjugation in different tenses.
2. In Latin, the desinent often reveals important grammatical information about the subject of the verb.
3. Students sometimes struggle to recognize the desinent when learning new languages.
4. Understanding the role of the desinent can greatly enhance one's linguistic skills.
5. The desinent can change the meaning of a word, depending on how it is used in a sentence.
