Meaning: Despatch (verb): To send off to a destination or for a purpose, typically in a timely manner.

1. The company will despatch the order within 24 hours of receiving payment.
2. She was tasked with despatching the invitations for the upcoming gala.
3. After careful consideration, they decided to despatch the prototype for testing.
4. The team worked late into the night to ensure they could despatch the final report on time.
5. A courier was hired to despatch the important documents across the city.
