

DESQUAMATE

Meaning: Desquamate: to shed or peel off the outer layer of skin.

1. The skin began to desquamate after the sunburn healed, revealing new layers beneath.
2. Patients with certain skin conditions may experience areas that desquamate irregularly.
3. After the treatment, the affected area started to desquamate, causing some discomfort.
4. Her dermatologist explained that it was normal for the treated skin to desquamate within a week.
5. The desquamate layer of the epidermis was gently removed during the facial treatment.
