

DETINUE

Meaning: Detinue is a legal term for a claim to recover goods that are wrongfully retained by another party.

1. The farmer filed a detinue against the neighbor who had taken his tools without permission.
2. In legal terms, detinue refers to a claim for the recovery of goods wrongfully retained.
3. The court ruled in favor of the plaintiff, granting the detinue for the return of the stolen artwork.
