

DETORT

Meaning: Detort (verb): to restore something to its original shape or form, especially after it has been twisted or distorted.

1. The engineer had to detort the twisted metal piece to restore its original shape.
2. To achieve a perfect curve, the artist decided to detort the clay sculpture carefully.
3. During the repair process, they had to detort the bent pipe before installation.
4. The technician used specialized tools to detort the warped frame of the window.
5. He learned how to detort the fabric so that it would lay flat and look presentable.
