

DEW-POINT

Meaning: Dew-point is the temperature at which air becomes saturated with moisture, leading to the formation of dew and influencing humidity levels.

1. The meteorologist explained how the dew-point affects humidity levels.
2. On a summer morning, the dew-point was high, making the air feel sticky and uncomfortable.
3. Understanding the dew-point can help predict the likelihood of fog forming overnight.
4. When the dew-point drops, it usually indicates a drier and cooler air mass is moving in.
5. Farmers often monitor the dew-point to assess the best time for irrigation.
