

# DEWCRAW

*Meaning: Dewclaw: a small, often non-weight-bearing digit on the inner side of a dog's leg, typically located above the main paw.*

1. The veterinarian carefully examined the dog's dewclaw during the check-up.
2. Some breeds, like the Great Pyrenees, are known for having prominent dewclaws.
3. Trimming the dewclaw is essential to prevent it from getting snagged on objects.
4. During the agility competition, the trainer noticed the dewclaw was slightly injured.
5. Many pet owners are unaware that dewclaws can sometimes require surgical removal.
