

DIACOPE

Meaning: Diacope is a rhetorical device that involves the repetition of a word or phrase with one or more intervening words, used to create emphasis or convey a particular emotional effect.

1. The poet's use of diacope in the phrase "to be or not to be" emphasizes the existential dilemma.
