

DIATONICALLY

Meaning: Diatonically refers to the use of notes that belong to a specific scale without incorporating chromatic alterations.

1. The melody progresses diatonically, staying true to the scale without using any chromatic notes.
2. In music theory, chords can be built diatonically from the notes of a given scale.
3. The composer preferred to write diatonically, allowing the natural harmonies of the key to shine through.
4. When improvising, she often used diatonically related notes to create a cohesive sound.
5. The piece's structure is primarily diatonically based, lending it a sense of stability and clarity.

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
