

DIFFIDENCE

Meaning: Diffidence is a lack of self-confidence or a hesitance to assert oneself, often resulting in shyness or reticence in social interactions.

1. Her diffidence in social situations often made her seem aloof, even when she was eager to connect.
2. Despite his brilliance, his diffidence prevented him from sharing his ideas in meetings.
3. The artist's diffidence about her work faded when she received praise from her peers.
4. Overcoming her diffidence took time, but she eventually found her voice in the debate.
5. His diffidence was mistaken for shyness, but he was simply a deep thinker who preferred to observe.
