*Meaning: DIPHTHONGALIZE: to modify or pronounce vowels as diphthongs, often to accommodate regional accents or improve clarity in speech.*

1. The linguist aimed to diphthongalize the standard vowels to reflect regional accents.
2. Teachers often encourage students to diphthongalize their pronunciations for clarity.
3. In her thesis, she proposed methods to diphthongalize certain vowel sounds in English.
4. The dialect of the area tends to diphthongalize monophthongs, giving it a unique sound.
5. To improve their speech, the actors practiced how to diphthongalize words effectively.
