

DIPHTHONGIC

Meaning: DIPHTHONGIC (adjective): relating to or characterized by a complex vowel sound that begins with one vowel and glides into another within the same syllable.

1. The term 'diphthongic' describes the complex vowel sounds that glide from one vowel to another within the same syllable.
2. In linguistic studies, diphthongic sounds are often contrasted with monophthong vowels, which maintain a single, steady sound.
3. Many languages feature diphthongic pronunciations that can significantly alter the meaning of words.
4. Phonetics classes frequently explore diphthongic elements to help students understand vowel production.
5. The diphthongic nature of a language can greatly influence its accent and regional dialects.

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
