

DIPHTHONGIZE

Meaning: DIPHTHONGIZE: to transform a single vowel sound into a diphthong, involving a glide from one vowel sound to another.

1. In linguistics, to diphthongize means to transform a vowel sound into a complex vowel sound that glides from one to another.
2. Some dialects of English tend to diphthongize certain monophthongs, creating a unique accent.
