

DIPLOIC

Meaning: Diploic refers to the veins or spaces located within the diploë, the spongy bone tissue between the inner and outer layers of the skull, involved in venous drainage.

1. The diploic veins play a crucial role in draining the blood from the skull's inner surfaces.
2. In certain medical conditions, the diploic space between the bone layers can become compromised.
3. Anatomists often describe diploic structures to help students understand cranial anatomy better.
4. During the surgery, the surgeon was careful to avoid damaging the diploic vessels.
