Meaning: Disaccommodate: to cause inconvenience or disruption to individuals who have made arrangements or accommodations.

1. The unexpected renovations at the hotel may disaccommodate several guests during peak season.
2. If the flight schedule changes again, it could disaccommodate many travelers who have already made plans.
3. Due to the flooding, the city has been forced to disaccommodate numerous residents from their homes.
4. The sudden policy shift might disaccommodate employees who were looking forward to the flexible work arrangements.
5. When the conference was canceled, it disaccommodated attendees who had traveled from afar to participate.
