Meaning: Disadvance (verb): to hinder or impede progress or advancement in a particular area or situation.

1. The new policy may inadvertently disadvance the progress made in recent years.
2. His lack of experience could disadvance his chances of securing the promotion.
3. Frequent errors in the report could disadvance the project timeline significantly.
4. The sudden changes in management might disadvance team morale and productivity.
5. Inconsistent funding can disadvance the initiatives aimed at community development.
