

# DISAFFIRMATION

*Meaning: Disaffirmation is the act of rejecting or nullifying a previously made agreement or contract.*

1. The disaffirmation of the contract left both parties uncertain about their next steps.
2. His disaffirmation of the agreement was unexpected, raising questions about his intentions.
3. The attorney advised her that a disaffirmation could lead to complications in the legal proceedings.
4. In the face of disaffirmation, the company had to reassess its obligations to the client.
5. The child's disaffirmation of the purchase was valid due to his age and lack of understanding.
