1. She strongly disapproves of his reckless spending habits.
2. The teacher did not hesitate to disapprove of the student's late submission.
3. Many parents disapprove of the new policy regarding phone use in schools.
4. He expressed his desire to disapprove of the decision during the meeting.
5. Friends often disapprove when they see someone compromising their values.
