*Meaning: Disauthorize: to revoke or annul a previously granted authorization or approval.*

1. The manager decided to disauthorize the previous approval due to budget constraints.
2. After a thorough review, the committee chose to disauthorize the project proposal.
3. In order to enhance security, the IT department will disauthorize all outdated user accounts.
4. The new policy will disauthorize any access to sensitive information without proper clearance.
5. To prevent misuse, the organization must disauthorize any unauthorized transactions immediately.
