

DISAVOWANCE

Meaning: Disavowance refers to the act of denying any responsibility for or association with something, often to distance oneself from controversial or undesirable beliefs or statements.

1. The politician's public disavowance of the controversial statement surprised many of his supporters.
2. Her disavowance of the group's extremist views was seen as a necessary step to maintain her reputation.
3. After much deliberation, the CEO issued a disavowance of the company's previous stance on environmental policies.
4. The artist's disavowance of the interpretation of her work was met with mixed reactions from critics.
5. In the face of mounting evidence, his disavowance of all involvement was both swift and emphatic.
