

# DISAVOWMENT

*Meaning: Disavowment is the act of denying responsibility for or rejecting association with something, often to protect one's reputation or position.*

1. The politician's disavowment of the controversial remarks sparked a heated debate among his supporters.
2. Her swift disavowment of the allegations was meant to protect her reputation and career.
3. The company's disavowment of any responsibility for the incident came as a surprise to many.
4. He issued a formal disavowment of the organization's past actions, seeking to distance himself from their controversial history.
5. The disavowment of the agreement left both parties in a precarious position, unsure of their next steps.
