Meaning: Disbend: to alter the direction or shape of something, especially by bending it back to a straight or original form, often used metaphorically to describe the easing of tension or distortion.

1. The scientist discovered a method to disbend the light rays, creating a stunning visual effect.

3. The artist used a unique technique to disbend the canvas, allowing for a more fluid representation of her vision.
