Meaning: Disblame: to absolve or exonerate someone from blame or responsibility for a mistake or wrongdoing.

1. The team sought to disblame the player for the critical error during the match.
2. In her heartfelt letter, she tried to disblame herself for the misunderstandings that had occurred.
3. He hoped to disblame his partner for the delays in the project, emphasizing external factors instead.
4. The community worked together to disblame the organization for the unfortunate incident, highlighting their good intentions.
5. As the investigation unfolded, it became clear that the goal was to disblame anyone involved rather than seek accountability.
