*Meaning: Disbud (verb): To remove selected buds from a plant to promote the growth of larger flowers or improve overall bloom quality.*

1. To achieve a fuller bloom, the gardener decided to disbud the roses.
2. The technique of disbudding is essential for producing larger, more impressive flowers.
3. She carefully disbudded the chrysanthemums to encourage better growth in the remaining buds.
