Meaning: Disburse: to pay out or distribute money, typically from a fund or account.

1. The foundation will disburse the funds to the eligible applicants by the end of the month.
2. After careful consideration, the committee decided to disburse the grant to several innovative projects.
3. It took weeks to finalize the paperwork before the bank could disburse the loan amount.
4. She was relieved when the insurance company agreed to disburse her claim after the accident.
5. The charity aims to disburse resources efficiently to ensure maximum impact in the community.
