

DISCALCEATE

Meaning: To discalceate means to remove one's shoes before entering a space, typically as a sign of respect or to maintain cleanliness.

1. It is customary to discalceate before entering a traditional Japanese home.
2. The children were asked to discalceate to keep the carpet clean during the party.
3. As we approached the sacred site, we were reminded to discalceate in respect of the local customs.
4. After a long day of hiking, I was eager to discalceate and let my feet breathe.
5. During the ceremony, participants were required to discalceate as a sign of humility.
