

DISCALCEATION

Meaning: Discalceation is the act of removing one's shoes, often as a ritualistic gesture of humility or respect before entering a sacred space.

1. The ritual of discalceation before entering the temple symbolized the shedding of worldly concerns.
2. During the ceremony, participants observed discalceation as a sign of humility and respect.
3. His discalceation on the beach felt liberating, allowing him to connect more intimately with the sand beneath his feet.
4. In some cultures, discalceation is practiced as a form of spiritual cleansing.
5. The children giggled as they performed discalceation, excited to feel the grass tickle their toes.

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
