

DISCLAMATION

Meaning: Disclamation: a formal statement or declaration that denies responsibility or disassociates from certain statements or events.

1. The author's disclamation at the beginning of the book clarified that the events were purely fictional.
2. In her speech, she included a disclamation to distance herself from any controversial opinions expressed by her colleagues.
3. The disclamation on the product packaging warned consumers about potential allergens.
4. He issued a formal disclamation to ensure that his views were not misrepresented in the media.
5. The disclamation served as a reminder that the views shared in the interview were his own and not those of the organization.
