Meaning: Discommend (verb): to express disapproval of or to advise against something.

1. It is often wise to discommend actions that could harm others.
2. The teacher discommends excessive screen time for young students.
3. In her review, she chose to discommend the film for its poor storyline.
4. The committee decided to discommend the project due to its environmental impact.
5. He felt it necessary to discommend the practices that undermine ethical standards.
