Meaning: Discommission refers to the process of officially removing a ship or vessel from active service or duty.

1. The navy decided to decommission the aging battleship after years of service.
2. After the research vessel's mission was completed, it was decommissioned and returned to the dock.
3. To reduce costs, the company chose to decommission several outdated production lines.
4. Following the merger, the board voted to decommission the redundant office spaces.
5. The government announced plans to decommission the facility due to budget cuts and a shift in priorities.
