Meaning: DISCOMPT (verb): To reduce the price of goods or services, often as a discount or special offer.

1. The retailer decided to discompt the seasonal items to clear out inventory.
2. To encourage more customers, the restaurant offered a discompt on all appetizers.
3. She was pleased to receive a discompt on her subscription renewal for the magazine.
4. The travel agency provided a significant discompt for group bookings to popular destinations.
5. After negotiating, he managed to secure a discompt on the overall cost of the service.
