

DISEMBOGUEMENT

Meaning: Disemboguement refers to the point at which a river or stream flows out into a larger body of water, such as an ocean or lake.

1. The disemboguement of the river into the ocean marked a significant point in the landscape.
2. After heavy rains, the disemboguement of the swollen creek created a dramatic change in the surrounding ecosystem.
3. Scientists studied the disemboguement area to understand how sediment was deposited in the delta.
4. The disemboguement of the canal allowed for better drainage and reduced flooding in the nearby fields.
5. As the water flowed towards its disemboguement, it carried with it various nutrients vital for marine life.

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
