

DISENTITLE

Meaning: To disentitle means to deprive someone of a right or entitlement, especially to benefits or claims.

1. The new policy could potentially disentitle many families from receiving crucial benefits.
2. If the evidence is found to be misleading, it may disentitle the applicant from further claims.
3. The court ruled that the contract's breach would disentitle the party from any compensation.
4. In some cases, failure to meet the requirements can disentitle individuals from accessing certain programs.
