

DISGARNISH

Meaning: Disgarnish (verb): to remove decorative or unnecessary elements from a dish to emphasize the main components.

1. The chef decided to disgarnish the plate, removing the unnecessary herbs to highlight the main dish.
2. After the elaborate dinner, she chose to disgarnish the dessert, favoring a simpler presentation.
3. In the art of food styling, sometimes it's best to disgarnish to let the colors of the main ingredients shine through.
4. He felt it was time to disgarnish his wardrobe, clearing out items that no longer suited his style.
5. The artist aimed to disgarnish the canvas, stripping away excess paint to reveal the raw texture underneath.
