Meaning: Disinvolve: to remove oneself or others from participation or involvement in a particular matter or situation.

1. The committee decided to disinvolve themselves from the ongoing controversy.
2. To ensure fairness, the judge chose to disinvolve any parties with conflicts of interest.
3. His attempt to disinvolve himself from the project only created more confusion among the team.
4. The new policy aims to disinvolve external influences that could compromise the integrity of the research.
5. She felt it was necessary to disinvolve her personal opinions from her professional responsibilities.
