

DISJUNCT

Meaning: Disjunct: a word or phrase in a sentence that indicates a choice or alternative, affecting the meaning of the statement.

1. The teacher explained that the disjunct in the sentence altered its overall meaning.
2. In logic, disjuncts are often used to indicate alternative possibilities within a statement.
3. The film's narrative structure felt disjunct, jumping between various time periods without warning.
