

DISPATHY

Meaning: Dispathy refers to a lack of empathy or emotional responsiveness towards one's own condition or the struggles of others.

1. The patient's dispathy towards his condition made it difficult for the doctor to provide effective treatment.
2. In discussions about mental health, dispathy often manifests as a lack of empathy towards others' struggles.
3. Her dispathy regarding the community's issues left her peers frustrated and seeking more engaged leadership.
4. Despite his dispathy, he was persuaded to volunteer at the local shelter to better understand the challenges faced by the less fortunate.
5. The teacher's dispathy toward her students' concerns hindered their ability to communicate openly about their needs.
