

DISPONEE

Meaning: DISPONEE: A person or entity to whom property or rights are transferred or conveyed in a legal transaction.

1. The disponee must ensure that all conditions of the transfer are met before proceeding.
2. In a legal context, the disponee acquires rights to the property in question once the contract is signed.
3. The original owner retained certain rights, which complicated the disponee's ability to use the land freely.
